## Course Description

The Level 5 Diploma in Education and Training (formerly known as the Diploma in Teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector or DTLLS) is a standard qualification for educators in the post-16 sector. This course is particularly beneficial for individuals aspiring to become teachers, streamlining the process of developing essential teaching skills. Notably, this Level 5 teaching certification holds special significance as it qualifies individuals to apply for Qualified Teacher Learning and Skills (QTLS) status, allowing them to teach in state schools in the United Kingdom.

Our fully online Level 5 DET course, accredited by UK OfQual, enhances both dual professionalism and teaching qualifications across various teaching contexts.

Although completion of the level 3 or level 4 courses is not a prerequisite for enrolling in our level 5 DET, it is mandatory to accumulate a minimum of 100 hours of teaching practice in an actual classroom by the completion of the qualification. Many candidates choose to initiate the course once they are in a teaching placement. In case you don't have a teaching placement, you may refer to our Trainee Teacher Positioning Program whereby we offer assistance to fulfil the practical component of your course.

As long as you satisfy the minimum criteria outlined in the course FAQs, you are eligible to enrol in the level 5 course without delay as the course is available for commencement at any time owing to the self-paced nature of our delivery model.
