## Course Description

The Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Dignity and Safeguarding in Adult Health and Social Care is designed for individuals who want to understand how adults are protected within care services and why dignity plays such an important role in professional care practice. The course introduces the responsibilities involved when supporting adults who may require care or assistance and explains why safeguarding is an essential part of everyday care work.

Supporting adults who may be vulnerable is a common responsibility in many health and social care roles. Because of this, workers need a clear understanding of safeguarding and the standards expected when providing care. This qualification helps explain those responsibilities and why protecting individuals from harm is such an important part of care practice.

Some learners take this course because they plan to work in adult health and social care in the future. Others choose it to strengthen their existing knowledge of safeguarding and professional responsibilities. Moreover, the course can also be useful for anyone who supports adults in community or care settings and wants to better understand how dignity and safety are maintained.

**Unit 3:** Understand duty of care in adult health and social care

## Assessment

Learners work through written assignments that explore safeguarding in adult health and social care. These tasks look at how signs of abuse or neglect might be recognised and what steps should be taken if a concern about someone's safety arises.

## Duration

The Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Dignity and Safeguarding in Adult Health and Social Care is delivered through online study, giving learners the flexibility to progress at their own pace. Many learners complete the course within 3 to 4 months, although access to the learning platform remains available for 12 months.
