Course Description

The Level 2 Diploma for the Early Years Practitioner is an Ofqual regulated qualification which helps the learner acquire the knowledge, skills and understanding needed to be able to work in early years settings and support children aged birth to seven years. This level 2 Early Years qualification enables learners to gain knowledge and understanding of child development, safeguarding, health and safety, equality and inclusive practice and support children's learning, development and wellbeing within the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

Moreover, our Level 2 Early Years Practitioner course focuses on the key areas of Safeguarding and welfare, supporting children's communication and development, promoting positive behaviour, supporting SEND, partnership working and planning activities and purposeful play opportunities. Learners have the ability to provide practical skills and professional knowledge to assist and support young children in early years settings under supervision. The qualification also enables learners to build confidence and competence in early years professional practice.

Assessment

Assessment for the Level 2 Diploma for the Early Years Practitioner is completed through a combination of written assignments, portfolio evidence, and workplace-based observations. Learners complete assignments to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of early years practice, while practical skills are assessed within a real work environment through observation and portfolio-based evidence.

Duration

The course is also offered at the self-paced learning and normally completing it takes 6-9 months depending on the pace that the learner takes. Course access remains available for 12 months from enrolment. If you need extra time past the initial access period, a re-enrolment fee will be charged.
