Course Description

The Level 3 Diploma for Working in the Early Years Sector (Early Years Educator) is an Ofqual regulated qualification which enables the learners to gain all the knowledge, skills and understanding they need to work in early years settings and to be registered in staff to child ratios. This level 3 early years qualification will allow the learners to gain knowledge of child development, safeguarding, health and wellbeing, and communication and inclusive practice whilst supporting children's learning and development.

Moreover, our Level 3 Early Years Educator course is specialized in such areas as holistic development, safeguarding and welfare, supporting SEND, curriculum planning, assessment and partnership working, at which learners are equipped with the skills of facilitating the learning among children, promoting their safety, and considering professional practice in various early years settings. The qualification also provides opportunities for progression onto employment or further learning and training in the early years sector and helps to develop confidence and competence as a professional.

Assessment

Assessment for the Level 3 Diploma for Working in the Early Years Sector (Early Years Educator) is completed through a combination of written assignments, portfolio evidence, and workplace-based observations. Learners complete assignments to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of early years practice.

Duration

The course is also offered at the self-paced learning and normally completing it takes 10-11 months depending on the pace that the learner takes. Course access remains available for 12 months from enrolment. If you need extra time past the initial access period, a re-enrolment fee will be charged.
